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Renewable LPG is the future for New Zealand

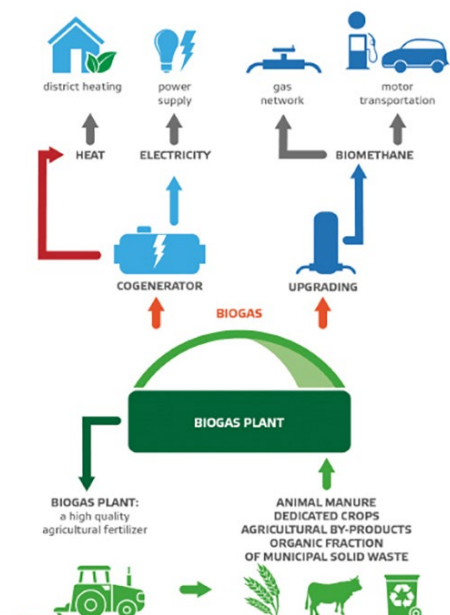


New Zealand's energy future could lie with renewable LPG, which is a clean burning, portable, high-energy fuel with a less carbon intensity than biomass.

Biogas and biomethane industries are strongly committed with the European Commission proposal to accelerate the reduction of methane emissions.

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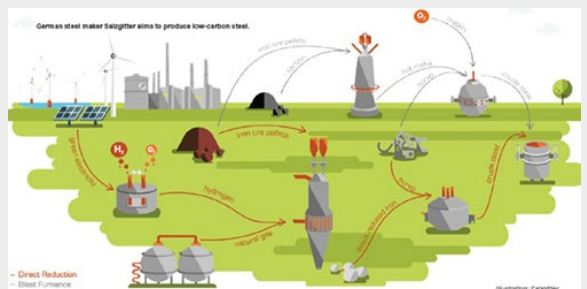
There is value in renewable and clean burning gas, industries say
